Adjacent to our hotel, this charming self catering cottage underwent extensive restoration 2010. In past years, this self catering cottage used to be the local sergeant's cottage in Lifton. Cleverly positioned next door to the Courthouse at the heart of this rural Devon village, it has been transformed into a beautiful two bedroom self catering holiday cottage. Perfect for those wanting a little more room or privacy, and of course for families and friends looking for the picture perfect holiday let in Devon.
A Genuinely Warm Welcome
Expect a warm welcome with a hamper of freshly baked homemade bread, milk and a bottle of wine. Towels are provided and a daily maid service can be arranged (at an extra cost). The real advantage of this self catering cottage is that you needn't go anywhere for your day to day needs. On the site we have the Courthouse Bar (the old Lifton courthouse) serving home cooked meals for lunch and dinner, and also serving real local draught ales and cider. In the main building we have the hotel bar serving light snacks and a brasserie style menu. Or we have our AA 2 rosette restaurant for breakfast, fine dining, á la carte and table d'hote menus.

Her book "West Country Fly Fishing," a collection of essays by experts and friends including Ted Hughes, Dermot Wilson, Brian Clarke and her late husband Conrad Voss Bark, is considered a classic. The past 50 years have been a period of warm welcomes and consistent high quality service to our guests. Whilst strong on traditional values and service, the hotel has never stood still and there have been a constant stream of improvements to the hotel. The hotel is now run by Adam and Tina Fox-Edwards who have maintained the ethos of the hotel whilst continuing to develop it.

These are spate rivers that rise on the moors and come down to our valleys through woods and farmland, becoming larger, deepening, providing an infinite variety of water, long slow pools, gravelly runs and stickles, fast shallows and open glides. Here you are alone all day, fishing a mile of river for wild brown trout - shy fish that rise savagely to a fly. In the late spring, the first salmon arrive and by mid-summer, shoals of sea trout bring out the night fishers. We teach fishing. We run courses for beginners. We sell tackle, give advice and provide maps of our fishing. It is all this and more which makes The Arundell Arms a real fisherman's hotel.
